Pilgrim Lutheran School is excited to partner with families in providing an education that is built on peace, joy, hope, and faith. Tuition is an investment into your child's educational and spiritual future.

Pilgrim Lutheran Church owns and operates Pilgrim Lutheran School as part of its mission to "Go and make disciples of all nations" (*Matthew 28:19*). We value the partnership we have with parents in Christ-centered education. "Dedicate a child to the way he should go, and even when he becomes old, he will not turn away from it" (*Proverbs 22:6*). Therefore, Pilgrim Lutheran Church automatically gives a grant to help cover the actual cost of education. The current three-year average to educate a child is approximately \$8,223. The members of Pilgrim happily contribute to the Christian education provided here for both members and non-members alike.

A \$100 non-refundable deposit is **required** at the time of pre-registration, unless you are applying for a School Choice Program or the SNSP Program\*. This amount will be credited to tuition upon enrollment.

**\* School Choice Information:** Our school participates in the Milwaukee Parental Choice Program and the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program. Students qualify for one of the programs on the basis of their residency and their family income. Families must prove their residency and their income if they are first-time applicants. Continuing students are not required to provide income documentation. However, they must still apply and provide residency documentation.

All students **MUST** reapply to the program each year. Apply online at <https://apps4.dpi.wi.gov/ChoiceParent> during an open enrollment period. Parental Choice applications are separate from the school registration.

**Tuition Assistance:** For families who do not qualify for a Choice Program, we encourage you to apply for tuition assistance with Pilgrim through FACTS. Tuition assistance is available to families who need help with tuition but do not qualify for a School Choice program. Please ask the office for a Pilgrim tuition assistance application. Once that paperwork is turned in you will receive directions on how to apply online with the FACTS website.
